

# Removing Screen Printing From Cotton or Other Natural Fabrics

## 1. Acetone

Soak the acetone over your design. Rub the design using a white rough cloth until it comes away.



## 2. Nail polish remover

Soak the nail polish remover in cotton balls and dab over the design. Wait a few minutes and scrub design area off with a stiff brush.



## 3. Iron & paper bag method

Set medium heat on iron (cotton setting) and place kraft paper over the design. Start ironing over the kraft paper until the design starts to soften. Use a toothpick or chopsticks to rub off the remaining ink.



## 4. Washing fabric by hand

Add the fabric to hot water, use detergent and let it soak (this should soften the print). Now rub the design using a dry towel and watch it peel off.



Always wear gloves when handling chemicals
